Though there is no one-size-fits-all route through the Sixth Form, students typically take 4 subjects in Year 12. In addition to their lessons (typically 4Hrs of contact teaching time for each subject, each week as above) they attend tutor time (x4), assembly (x1) and GMAMES (2.5Hrs) each week. All students will also have up to 3Hrs of timetabled SPS (Supervised Private Study) each week in addition to any mentoring, work experience or extra-curricular time they may enjoy. Students are expected to take AS examinations in each of their chosen subjects, needing to secure a minimum D grade to continue the subject in to Year 13 (and full A Level).
